the way of action.

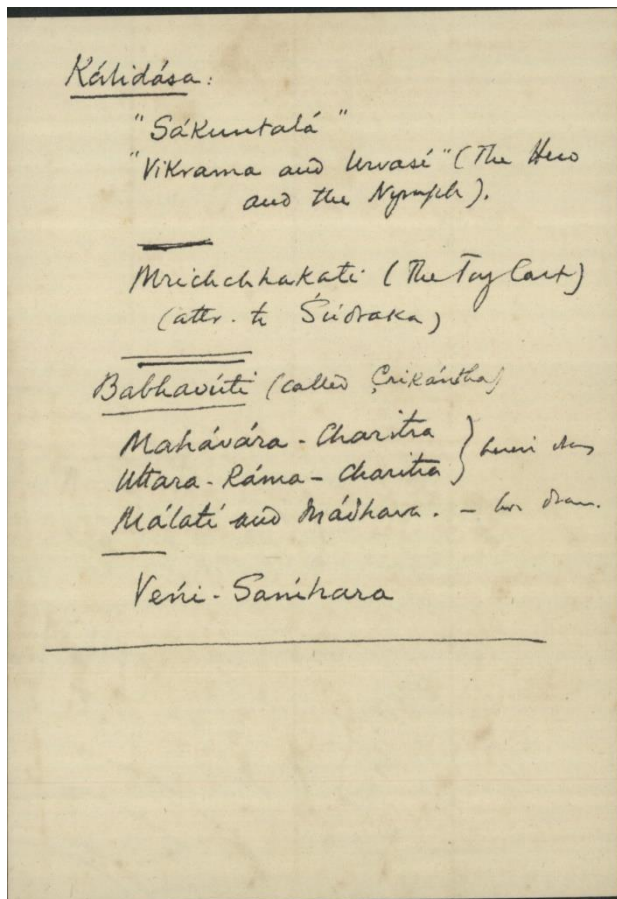
"Every imitation of action by action is in germ a
