The classification by end {...}

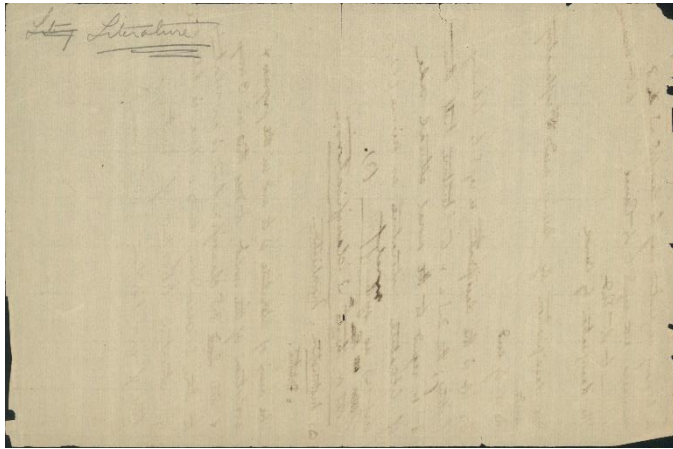
