

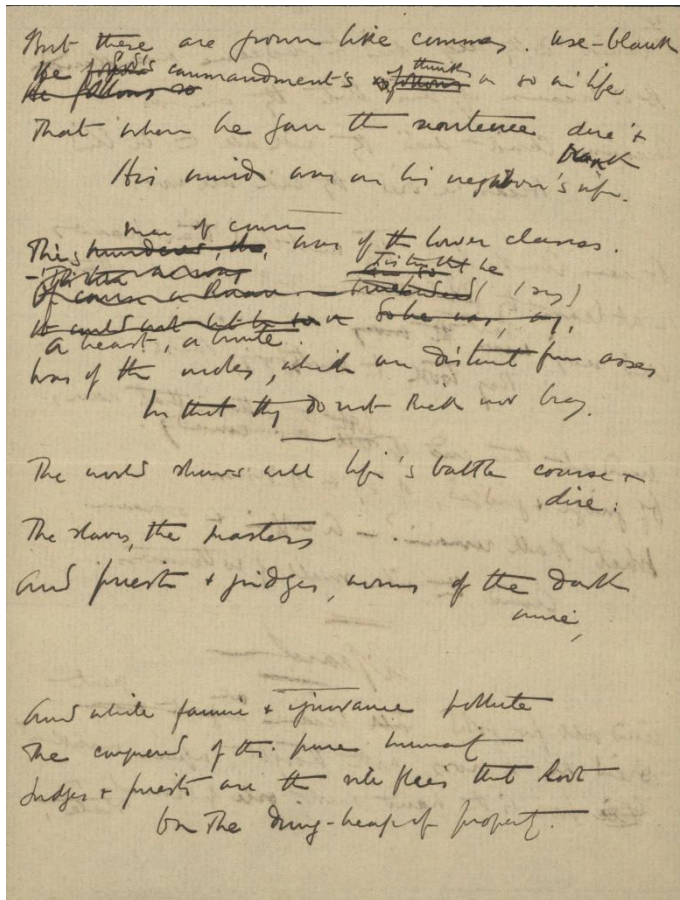
"Christ" do they say "died to redeem mankind".
