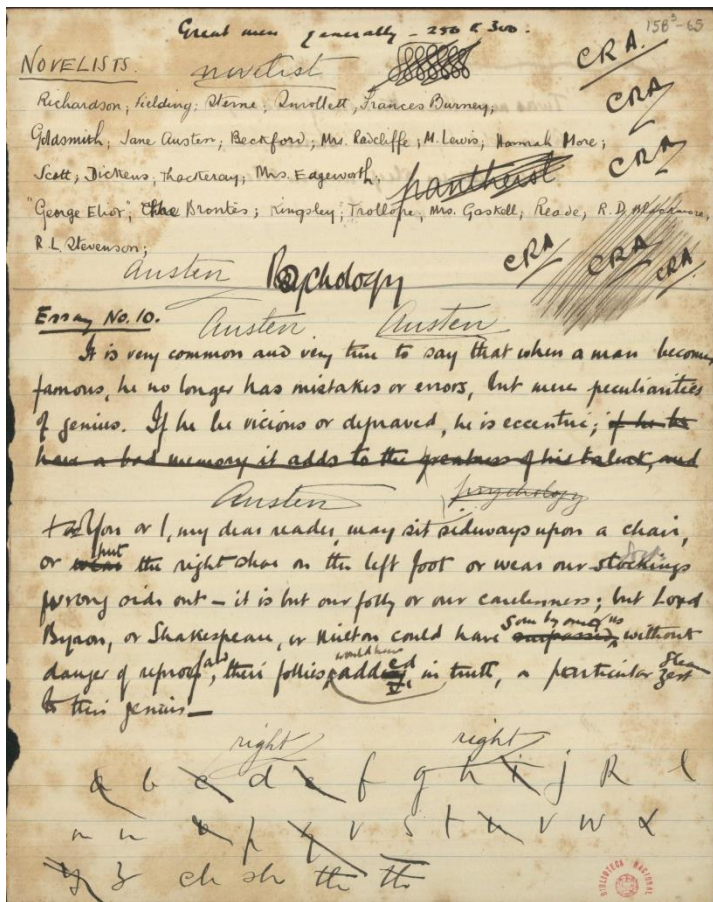

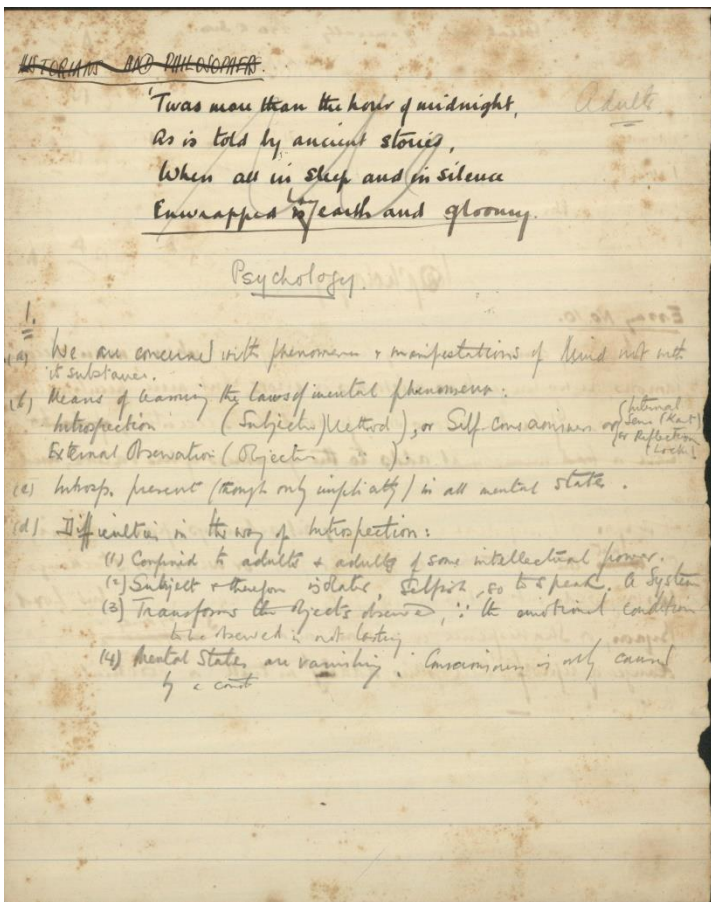

 - (a) We are concerned with phenomena and manifestations of Mind not with its substance.
 - (b) Means of learning the laws of internal phenomena:
Introspection (Subjective Method), or Self-Conscious or Internal Sense (Kant) or Reflection (Locke)
External Observation (Objective Method)
 - (c) Introspection present (though only implicitly) in all mental states.
 - (d) Difficulties in the way of Introspection:
 - (1) Confined to adults and adults of some intellectual power.
 - (2) Subject and therefore isolates, selfish, so to speak. A System
 - (3) Transforms the objects observed, because the emotional condition to be observed is not lasting.
 - (4) Mental States are vanishing. Consciousness is only caused by a cut.
